

## MT. LEBANON TRAFFIC BOARD

Meeting Date: October 7, 2020

Mr. Wayne opened the meeting.

Agenda Item 1: Roll Call, Ms. Krieger was absent.

Agenda Item 2: Opening Remarks from Chair

Agenda Item 3: Meeting Notes from March 4, 2020.

Motion was made to approve the minutes from the March 4, 2020 meeting. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

### **Old Business:**

Agenda Item 4: Update on Arden Road Traffic Calming Study.

Mr. Haberman, Gateway Engineers reported that due to Covid-19 no additional data has been collected. The data collection will take place in October once students return to in-person schooling. Mr. Haberman stated that the analysis and report preparation will take about 4 weeks and an update will be provide at the November meeting, with a neighborhood meeting planned for December. A formal recommendation will then be presented to the Traffic Board.

Agenda Item 5: Request for Left Turn Arrow on Traffic Signal on Washington Road at Woodhaven Road.

Mr. Haberman reported that due to Covid-19 data has not been collected. Data collection is scheduled for the week of October 19 once students have returned to in-person schooling. Board members suggested tabling this item until traffic volumes return to normal levels once commuters return to work and school is back in session full time. Commissioner Silverman agreed that this request should be tabled. No further action was taken.

Agenda Item 6: Request for Parking Restrictions on Clokey Avenue Near Bower Hill Road.

Mr. Haberman, Gateway Engineers reported that a motion was made at the March meeting to approve parking restrictions on Clokey Avenue. Letters were sent to residents inviting them to the meeting to present any concerns they may have. Mr. Jeffrey Shaw, 411 Clokey Avenue spoke in favor of the parking restrictions on Clokey at the intersection with Bower Hill due to the width of the road and visibility when vehicles are parked close to the intersection. Motion from the March meeting stands. No further action.

Agenda Item 9: Request to Review Width Measurements of Kenmont Avenue.

Mr. Haberman reported that a motion was made at the March meeting to recommend the approval of parking on both sides of Kenmont Avenue between Dell Avenue and Edward Avenue. Mr. Carmine Bellini requested clarification on the width of Kenmont Avenue between Edward Avenue and Bower Hill. The motion to recommend approval of parking on both sides of Kenmont Avenue between Dell Avenue and Edward Avenue will stand with the approval of the Municipal Fire Chief. No further action.

Agenda Item 10: Request for Increased Lighting at Crosswalk on Bower Hill Road at Greenhurst Drive.

Mr. Haberman stated that a determination was made that this is not an issue for the Traffic Board.

**New Business:**

Agenda Item 11: Request for Stop Signs on Jefferson Drive at Poplar Drive

Mr. Haberman reported that he received this request from a resident. Mr. Haberman did not feel the intersection would meet the volume threshold to warrant stop signs but a site review will be conducted to measure site distance. Report will be presented at the November meeting.

Agenda Item 12: Request for Traffic Study on Lakemont Drive

Mr. Haberman stated that the person submitting this request was advised of the Traffic Calming procedures. No one was present to discuss this item. Item will be tabled until a petition is presented to the board. No further action was taken.
